This guide for authors, in preparing manuscripts and drawings for the most effective and economical method of publishing biological research, has been prepared by the Staff of The Wistar Institute Press and the coöperative efforts of more than fifty editors concerned in the editing of journals published by The Wistar Institute, and presents the consensus of opinion on many points relating to the mechanical preparation of manuscripts and drawings for the printer and engraver. Due attention has been given to the relative costs of various methods of reproducing tables and illustrations with a view to reducing the costs of publishing papers.

The work has been revised, rewritten and enlarged since the first copy was prepared and submitted to editors, in order to offer as much information and illustrative material on the subject as is possible within reasonable limits.

It will save authors much time and expense in preparing papers for publication and tend to expedite the publication of research.
