

American Institute of Nutrition Fellows Invitation for Nominations for 1992

The Fellows Committee of the American Institute of Nutrition invites nominations for Fellows. Scientists who have had distinguished careers in nutrition and are at least sixty-five years of age are eligible for nomination. Membership in the Institute is not a requirement for eligibility. Up to ten Fellows may be chosen each year, of whom two may be citizens of countries other than the United States and Canada.

Nominations may be made by any active or emeritus member of the Institute. Send nominations, including a supporting statement setting forth the basis of the nomination, to the Chairman of the Fellows Committee by October 1. Final selection will be made by the committee, and a suitable citation will be presented at the annual meeting.
